AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 19, 1953 (P.L.279, No.54), entitled "An
2 act to prohibit operation of boats having a developed
3 horsepower rating in excess of ten on Canadohta Lake, in
4 Crawford County," further providing for the use of boats with
5 motors.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. The act of June 19, 1953 (P.L.279, No.54),
9 entitled "An act to prohibit operation of boats having a
10 developed horsepower rating in excess of ten on Canadohta Lake,
11 in Crawford County," is amended by adding a section to read:

12 Section 1.1. Any boat equipped with a motor in excess of ten
13 horsepower rating may be operated on Canadohta Lake in Crawford
14 County if the motor is rendered inoperable by removal of the
15 propeller, and such propeller is left ashore. After removal of
16 the propeller, a motor of not more than ten horsepower rating
17 may be attached to the boat and used for propelling the boat on
18 Canadohta Lake.

19 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
